

**City of Pioneer Village
Regular City Council Meeting
March 28, 2017**

Regular Meeting of the Pioneer Village City Council was held at City Hall Becknall Community Center, 4700 Summitt Drive, Louisville, KY 40229. Gary W. 


Phillip Radford made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Denver Matthews 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
