MINUTES REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING FEBRUARY 27, 2018 7PM

Regular City Council Meeting of Pioneer Village held at City Hall Becknall Community Center 4700 Summitt Drive Louisville, KY 40229. Gary W. Hatcher called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Council members present: Mike Exton, Dorleen Garrett, Gary Wilson, Peggy Druin, and Denver Matthews. Council member absent: Phillip Radford. Also, in attendance: City Attorney Mark Edison, City Clerk Micheale McCauley.

City Clerk Micheale McCauley read the minutes from the Special City Council Meeting December 18, 2017. Peggy Druin made a motion to accept the minutes from the December Special City Council Meeting. Denver Matthews 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Mike Exton made a motion to accept the Financial Report from December 18, 2017. Peggy Druin 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

No Quorum for January 23, 2018 Regular City Council Meeting.

Gary Wilson made a motion to accept the Financial Report from January 23, 2018. Denver Matthews 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

City Attorney Mark Edison read the 2nd reading of the Vacation Ordinance 2017-06. Mike Exton made a motion to accept the Vacation Ordinance 2017-06. Peggy Druin 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

City Attorney Mark Edison read the first reading of Ordinance 2018-01 for the Code of Ordinances Supplement.

Mayor Gary Hatcher informed the Council about the Proclamation for National School Choice Week that took place in January 2018.

Mayor Gary Hatcher presented Mrs. Delois Robinson a plaque for her husband's 16 years of service to the Pioneer Village Police Merit Board.

Mike Exton made a motion to appoint John Forst to the Merit Board with a 2-year term. Peggy Druin 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Peggy Druin made a motion to re-appoint Merit Board members Tim Holbrook and Jon Sutton for another 2-year term. Denny Matthews 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Mayor Gary Hatcher proposed to change the name of Park Avenue to Cobblestone Avenue due to semi's entering the neighborhood damaging the signs and resident's property. He also advised this change would not affect any current residents. Peggy Druin made a motion to change the name of Park Avenue to Cobblestone Avenue. Gary Wilson 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Mayor Gary Hatcher asked the Council if they would like to have a Pioneer Village Clean-Up Day this year. After a short discussion, it was decided the Clean-up Day will be on Saturday April 21, 2018 from 8am-12pm with a rain date of Saturday April 28, 2018 from 8am-12pm.

Peggy Druin reported there is a dip on John Harper Highway where the repaving stopped and started. She inquired about getting it fixed. Attorney Mark Edison will send out a letter to the State to inform them the road need fixed. Also, there was discussion about the construction of sewers being put in near John Harper Highway.

Chief DJ Reynolds reported a car break-in that occurred on Dulcie Ct on Feb 5th in which a purse and wallet was stolen, and they rummaged through the car too. Also reported on the same day at 12651 Spring Haven Ct there were copper lines cut from the a/c units totaling approximately \$1000. The Chief reported that except for the theft reports on the 5th that it has been mostly quiet in the City.

Magistrate Joe Laswell had no report.

Tony Thompson from Planning and Zoning had no report affecting Pioneer Village.
