MINUTES SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MAY 29, 2018 7PM

Regular City Council Meeting of Pioneer Village held at City Hall Becknall Community Center 4700 Summitt Drive Louisville, KY 40229. Gary W. Hatcher called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.


PUBLIC BUSINESS
