MINUTES REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING FEBRUARY 26, 2019 AT 7PM

Regular City Council Meeting of Pioneer Village held at City Hall Becknall Community Center 4700 Summitt Drive Louisville, KY 40229.

Mayor Gary Hatcher called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Council Members present Denver Matthews, Peggy Druin, Mike Exton, Phillip Radford, Dorleen Garrett and Gary Wilson. No absences. Also, in attendance: City Attorney Mark Edison and City Clerk Micheale McCauley

Invocation by Denver Matthews

All recited the Pledge of Allegiance

- ✚ Clerk McCauley read the regular meeting minutes from January 22, 2019. Peggy Druin made a motion to accept the regular meeting minutes from January 22, 2019. Dorleen Garrett 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- ✚ Peggy Druin made a motion to accept the financial report from January 31, 2019. Dorleen Garrett 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Peggy Druin made a motion to remove the Maryville Playground Request from the table. Gary Wilson 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

The Council collectively rejected donating monies to Maryville Elementary for a playground when the residents already pay a school tax. Mayor Hatcher suggested to earmark \$5,000 for a playground on the lot next to City Hall.

Gary Wilson made a motion to remove the Mosquito Sprayer from the table. Peggy Druin 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Mayor Hatcher review the quotes from Clarke on the mosquito equipment and suggests the City purchase equipment with out GPS. The Council inquired about pricing to see if there is equipment available not as expensive. Also, the Council expressed concern of not being cost effective to purchase. Mayor Hatcher was asked by Mayor Clark of Hebron Estates to table Mosquito Sprayer until he can take it before his Council. Mike Exton made a motion to table Mosquito Sprayer. Dorleen Garrett 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Hatcher informed the Council that the auditor, Tom Atkisson was not able to attend meeting due to his workload. Three copies of audit must be sent to the state before March 31, 2019 therefore Mayor Hatcher suggests the Council approve with the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Audit Report. Peggy Druin made a motion to approve the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Audit Report. Dorleen Garrett 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Attorney Mark Edison read the Resolution 2019-01 Supporting Addressing the Modernization of Kentucky's Transportation Funding Mechanisms to Address Transportation Funding Needs Throughout the Commonwealth.

Resolution 2019-01 died due to lack of motion.

COUNCIL BUSINESS

Peggy Druin states her customer are asking what the City is doing with the property purchased next to City Hall. Peggy Druin volunteered to head the Committee and research for the future development of property. A newsletter will be created for residents with the help of Peggy Druin and the City Clerk.

Mayor Hatcher informed the Council the stores were out of cold patch and the City will take care of the potholes as soon as possible.

There was discussion as to what the speed limit is on the new road (Preston Highway). Mayor Hatcher states speed limit is 55 mph.

Absent, no report.


