## POLICE BUSINESS

June Run Report for Pioneer Village Police Department totals 184 responses.

Chief DJ Reynolds reported the following events:

- ❖ Most criminal runs were in the Hebron Estates area, including a very serious burglary on 7/1. The back door kicked in, several items taken include TV's, guns, jewelry and damage to house. This burglary is still under investigation and was put on the local news stations.
- ❖ The suspects pictures and video from the Storage 911 break-in was also put on the news stations in hopes of getting their identities.
- ❖ Received a run on 7/22 for a 12-year-old male juvenile who walked off from the Hillview Wal-Mart. Louisville Metro had several units looking for him along with Pioneer Village PD. He was found at Preston Hwy and Lodie Lane walking to his house. He was returned to his Grandmother.
- ❖ The news stations have put out that there have been several vehicles stolen and broken into in the area. Chief Reynolds says we have not had any more than usual this time of year. In order to help prevent theft: LOCK your cars, houses and garages.




Stephen Thomas from the Pioneer News introduced the new intern Clair Smith.
