**MINUTES REGULAR** CITY COUNCIL MEETING 7PM, AUGUST 27, 2019

Regular City Council Meeting of Pioneer Village held at City Hall Becknall Community Center 4700 Summitt Drive Louisville, KY 40229.

Mayor Gary Hatcher called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Invocation by Denver Matthews

All recited the Pledge of Allegiance

- ✚ Clerk McCauley read the regular meeting minutes from July 27, 2019. Peggy Druin made a motion to accept the regular meeting minutes. Dorleen Garrett 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
  - ✚ Denver Matthews made a motion to accept the financial report from July 31, 2019. Gary Wilson 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

## OLD BUSINESS

- ✚ Attorney Mark Edison read the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Ordinance 2019-03 Real Property Ad Valorem Tax. The Council discussed raising the rate and by how much according to the FY19-20 Rate Calculation Worksheet prepared by Attorney Mark Edison. Gary Wilson suggests raising as much without the recall, which would be .1285% per 100, Mike Exton and Mayor Hatcher agreed.
- ✚ Gary Wilson made a motion to set the tax rate for Ordinance 2019-03 Real Property Ad Valorem Tax Rate to .1285%. Denver Matthews 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- ✚ Attorney Mark Edison read the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Ordinance 2019-04 Personal Property Ad Valorem Tax. Mayor Hatcher advised the Council that .2000% per 100 is a good rate to compensate for the lack of industry, loss of Quasi revenue and the increase cost for retirement.
- ✚ Peggy Druin made a motion to set the tax rate for Ordinance 2019-04 Personal Property Ad Valorem Tax & Ordinance 2019-05 Public Service Companies Ad Valorem Tax Rate to 20.00% each. Gary Wilson 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- ✚ Mike Exton made a motion to accept Ordinance 2019-03 Real Property Ad Valorem Tax Rate to 12.85%. Dorleen Garrett 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- ✚ Peggy Druin made a motion to accept Ordinance 2019-04 Personal Property Ad Valorem Tax & Ordinance 2019-05 Public Service Companies Ad Valorem Tax Rate to 20.00% each. Dorleen Garrett 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried

- ✚ Mayor Hatcher informed the Council that he and other Bullitt County Mayors met with Congressman Bret Guthrie on August 26, 2019.
- ✚ Denver Matthews inquired if Tony Thompson is still working as our Planning and Zoning liaison, Mayor Hatcher said he is.

## POLICE BUSINESS

July Run Report for Pioneer Village Police Department totals 213 responses. Chief DJ Reynolds reported the following events:

- ❖ Two very serious accidents on Preston Hwy: One at Shepherds Way where a man on a motorcycle was struck and killed on August 13<sup>th</sup> at 8:30am. The second one at Hebron Lane where two people were seriously injured along with a service dog.
- ❖ Storage 911 break-in by someone cutting the fence and driving into the facility. There were 21 units broken in to. This all happened 10 minutes after officer made rounds.
- ❖ Chief Reynolds received information that schools in KY and Arkansas may be targeted in the next few days. Pioneer Village will be doing extra patrols at all the schools for the rest of the week.
- ❖ Pioneer Village Police are still doing extra traffic enforcement on Preston Hwy in the morning at Little Flock Church.
