ORDINANCE NO. 89- 3

An Ordinance setting minimum road construction standards located within the corporate boundaries of the City of Pioneer Village.

The City Council of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does ordain as follows:

SECTION I: That all new roads, streets and highways constructed within the corporate limits of Pioneer Village shall be constructed according to the following standards:

6 inches compacted dense grade aggregate crushed stone, 2 inches of compacted asphalt binder; and a 1 inch compacted asphalt surface.

SECTION II: Any land owner or developer shall cause to be certified that any new road has been constructed according to the standards set out in this ordinance.

SECTION III: Any new roads, highways, or streets constructed after the effective date of this ordinance which has not been constructed according to the regulations imposed herein shall not be accepted by the City of Pioneer Village, and the duty ^{to} maintain said highway, road or street shall fall on the owner of the roadway and/or owners of the lots served by said roadways, streets and highways.

SECTION IV: This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption and publication.

SECTION V: The Clerk is directed to advertise the above ordinance as provided by law.
