

ORDINANCE NUMBER 98-009

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING
A PORTION OF
SPRINGMEADOW DRIVE
IN THE CITY OF
PIONEER VILLAGE, KENTUCKY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Pioneer Village, Kentucky,
that:

Pursuant to K.R.S. 82.405 (Procedure for closing a public way.) the Council may close a public way, or portion of a public way, upon determination that a public way, or portion of public way located within the city should be closed, and

Having determined that Springmeadow Drive is located within the City of Pioneer Village, and it is in the best interest of the citizens of Pioneer Village to close a portion of Springmeadow Drive, because of health and safety concerns, and

All of the abutting property owners having failed to consent to the closing of a portion of Springmeadow Drive,

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: A portion of Springmeadow Drive in Pioneer Village, described hereinafter, shall be and hereby is CLOSED, and being that portion bounded as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe in the Southwest corner of Lot 33 of SPRING MEADOW SUBDIVISION, SECTION 3, recorded at Plat Cabinet 1, Slide 779, thence N 36° 54' 17" W 60.40 feet to an iron pin, thence N 18° 58' 19" E 2 feet, thence S 36° 54' 17" E 60.40 feet, thence S 18° 58' 18" W, 2 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION TWO: The Owners abutting the portion of Spring Meadow Drive to be closed are:

SECTION THREE: The City Attorney, after passage of this


