

ORDINANCE 98-010

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullit County, Kentucky.

The City Council finding for the better of, peace, dignity and gratitude of the community, and to promote public safety, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

It shall be unlawful to park a motor vehicle, truck, or boat, or unless owned by a corporations or organization holding an 501 (3) Federal Exemption, overnight on any off street public parking area or vacant property.

SECTION II Definitions

Motor Vehicle- a motor vehicle operating on two or more wheels.

Truck- trucks with a load capacity of over 1000 pounds.

Boat- row boat, motor boat, pontoon boat or house boat

Overnight parking- shall mean form 9:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. the following day

Off Street- area located off main streets and thoroughfares, easements, and parking lots

Employees- anyone working for a business, both public and private, for wages

SECTION III Exceptions

This ordinance does not pertain to businesses that are open between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. or any of its employees.

SECTION IV Penalty

Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per day, each day being a separate offense.

SECTION V Other ordinances not repealed

Nothing contained herein shall be deemed to repeal or modify any other ordinances heretofore enacted and in force in the City of Pioneer Village, unless specifically repealed by separate ordinances.

SECTION VI Severability

The provisions of this ordinance are several. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any particular case is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutional, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or repeal any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this ordinance, it being the legislative intent of the City Council to ordain and enact each provision, section, paragraph, sentence and part hereof separately and independently of each other.

SECTION VII Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective upon publication.
