

Ordinance No 02-002

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING LIMITED SALE OF ALCHOL BEVERAGES BY THE DRINK WITHIN THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the city of Pioneer Village is a fourth class city and which prohibitions not in effect, and;

WHEREAS, the city of Pioneer Village has determined that due to the hardship of the 1996 tornado, a economic hardship does exist within the City of Pioneer Village, Kentucky.

WHEREAS, the sale of alcoholic beverages by the drink could aid in economic growth.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY THAT:

SECTION ONE: There is hereby established by the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, the permitting of limited sale of alcoholic beverages by the drink, as authorized pursuant to KRS242.185

SECTION TWO: The annual fee for the issuance Liquor by the drink license

SECTION THREE: Before a Liquor by the drink license is issued, the applicant must be:

- (1) The owner or lessee of a restaurant which the minimum of fifty-five percent (55%) of their gross receipts form the sale of food.
- (2) Minimum seating capacity of one hundred (100) persons.

SECTION FOUR: This license shall be subject to any additional requirements imposed by the Commonwealth of Kentucky, or the Alcoholic Beverage Control Commission.


SECTION FIVE: This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

SECTION SIX: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional, or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION SEVEN: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
