

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-01

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE REGULAR MEETING TIME OF CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky had previously by Ordinance established 7:00 p.m. as the regular meeting time for City Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, the new City Council has determined that 7:00 p.m. is creating a hardship on City Council members being present to begin the meeting in a timely manner, and

WHEREAS, this dislocation of the operation of City government has resulted in inconvenience to the City, City Council, and general public resulting in an emergency situation, and

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statutes require the time for beginning regular City Council meetings to be established by ordinance to adequately inform the general public of the correct time when the public's business is performed, and

The City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: The regular meeting date, time and location of the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, shall be on the fourth Tuesday night of each month at 7:30 p.m. at the City Hall, 4700 Summitt Drive, Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall become effective upon first reading, approval, and publication, as an emergency condition has been declared to exist as set forth herein pursuant to KRS 83A.060(7).

SECTION THREE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are repealed.

SECTION FOUR: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
