

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-09

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FLASHING LIGHTS MOUNTED IN/ON POLICE VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Kentucky has by statute established a uniform standard for flashing lights on emergency/police vehicles, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to provide by Ordinance if the City Police vehicles are to be equipped with more than one color of flashing lights, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council based upon the advise of the Chief of Police of the City of Pioneer Village that both red and blue flashing lights would enhance public safety, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: Based on the authority of KRS 189.920(3), each police vehicle of the City of Pioneer Village shall be equipped with a combination of red and blue flashing, rotating or oscillating lights visible under normal atmospheric conditions from a distance of five hundred (500) feet to the front of the vehicle. This equipment shall be in addition to any other equipment required by the motor vehicle laws.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall be published according to law.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to KRS 189.920, et. seq.

SECTION FOUR: Any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance.

Given second reading, voted upon and passed at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 27th day of November, 2007.
