

**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-05**

AN ORDINANCE FORBIDDING THE DISCHARGE OF ANY DANGEROUS INSTRUMENTALITY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky as follows:

SECTION ONE: No person shall cast, throw, propel, or discharge any missile, arrow, firearm, spear, or any other item which may cause injury to a person or animal on any street, alley, other public place, or across property boundary lines within the city limits of the City of Pioneer Village.

SECTION TWO: Fireworks will be allowed during the hours of 9:00 p.m. thru 11:00 p.m. each day on the following days: July 3, July 4, and July 5, and during the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. each day on the following days: December 31 and January 1.

SECTION THREE: Any person who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

SECTION FIVE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION SIX: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Given second reading, voted upon and passed at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 23rd day of August, 2011.
