

## ORDINANCE NO. 2016-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 3 GENERAL PROVISIONS SECTION B BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS OF ORDINANCE NO. 2016-01 FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky had previously by Ordinance established a Flood Damage Prevention program for the City of Pioneer Village, and

WHEREAS, the State of Kentucky has mandated a specific date that must be used in said Ordinance to be in compliance with the State and Federal guidelines, and

WHEREAS, the incorrect date was included in Article 3 Section B, and

WHEREAS, failure to have the correct date included in this Ordinance would result in the residents of the City being required to pay much higher federal flood insurance rates, and

WHEREAS, this amendment must be approved by the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village prior to April 5, 2016, which is not possible without an emergency declaration by the City Council, now therefore;

The City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: Article 3 Section B of Ordinance 2016-01 is hereby amended to read as follows:

### SECTION B. BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREAS

The areas of special flood hazard identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) for Bullitt County, dated ~~June 15, 2015~~, April 5, 2016, with the accompanying Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMS), other supporting data and any subsequent amendments thereto, are hereby adopted by reference and declared to be a part of these regulations by the City of Pioneer Village, and for those land areas acquired by the City of Pioneer Village through annexation. This FIS and attendant mapping is the minimum area of applicability of this ordinance and may be supplemented by studies for other areas which allow implementation of this ordinance and which are recommended to the City Council by the Floodplain Administrator and are enacted by City Council pursuant to statutes governing land use management regulations. The FIS and/or FIRM are permanent records of the City of Pioneer Village and are on file and available for review by the public during regular business hours at Pioneer Village City Hall, 4700 Summitt Drive, Louisville, Bullitt County, Kentucky 40229.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall become effective upon first reading, approval, and publication, as an emergency condition has been declared to exist as set forth herein pursuant to KRS 83A.060(7).

SECTION THREE: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are repealed.

SECTION FOUR: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
