NEW BUSINESS

- ⚡ 4622 Springfield Ct – Attorney Edison searched for any licensed vehicles, no death on owner and owner has been in foreclosure at least 4 times in the past several years and corrected issues. Citations were started on 6/3/2020 for \$100.00 for High Grass and Weeds. Attorney Edison suggests if not cleaned up, for the City to clean up and file a lien on the property. The mailman said no one was picking up the mail.
- ⚡ Mayor Hatcher suggests he will find someone to contract to clean up property. Peggy Druin made a motion for Mayor Hatcher to find someone to contract to clean up property. Dorleen Garrett 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

- ⚡ Denver Matthews states many neighbors are complaining about 3306 Pioneer Trail which include the following:
 - There is a rollback bringing cars to the property
 - Resident is not considerate to neighbors with the amount of noise
 - Resident still conducting business out of his home without a business license.
- ⚡ Denver Matthews inquiring about the Firework Tent on Kearney's Car Lot. Mayor Hatcher states Kearney's did everything correctly with the Fire Marshall, County and paid the City the fee of \$1000.00 to obtain his temporary business license to sell fireworks in Pioneer Village.

- ⊕ Mike Exton stated that most of the fireworks being heard in Pioneer Village were from the Hillview residents.

POLICE BUSINESS

Police run report for May included 161 runs.

- ⊕ The City of Hebron Estates agreed to reimburse Pioneer Village for the initial cost of software for the police in car computers (MDT). The cost is \$806.00. This is for the new CAD system requirements.
- ⊕ The new radios will be up and running in August 2020 for all departments.
- ⊕ 6/1 and 6/5 at John Harper Hwy & Preston Hwy – injury accidents.
- ⊕ 6/7 at Cardinal Ave during the night someone broke into a work van parked in driveway, several high dollar items were taken from the medical van. The homeowner had cameras but did not capture anyone. This case is still under investigation.
- ⊕ 6/9 at Mini's U-Stuff-It on Summitt Dr – a U Haul pick-up truck was reported stolen (not returned). Three days later the vehicle was recovered by Radcliff Police Department and there was an arrest made.
- ⊕ 6/12 at Preston Hwy & Hebron Ln – non-injury accident.
- ⊕ 6/15 on Spring Trace Ct – homeowner was scammed out of \$2000.00 by buying Target gift cards. The caller was out of New Jersey.


