- ⚡ July 7th – Ruby Way in Hebron Estates – Officer Hibbs & McNear responded to call of an unresponsive male. The Officer Hibbs placed male on the floor and started performing CPR until Fire arrived and took over. Due to the quick action of Officer Hibbs the male is alive today. Next month we will present Officer Hibbs with a lifesaving award.

- ⚡ Absent no report.


PUBLIC BUSINESS

There are 10 different committees within the HOA. Below are some of the issues the HOA would like to be addressed with City:
 - Speed on Spring Meadow Drive – possible solution with speed signs or speed humps.
 - Entrance by John Harper Hwy – widen and improve with a digital sign and a flagpole.
 - Pressure wash the brick lights.
 - Want to change name of subdivision restrictions listed on website.
 - People should be able to find city website.
 - Possible temporary street closures for events to raise money for HOA.
 - Lighting at entrance off of John Harper Hwy.
- ⚡ Mayor Hatcher states there is an Ordinance against the closure of streets due to Fire Regulations.
