

**City of Pioneer Village
Regular City Council Meeting
July 26, 2016**

Regular Meeting of the Pioneer Village City Council was held at City Hall Becknall Community Center, 4700 Summitt Drive, Louisville, KY 40229. Gary W. Hatcher called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Members present: Peggy Druin, Darlene Herps, Denver Matthews, and Gary Wilson. Dorleen Garrett and Phillip Radford were absent. Others in attendance were City Attorney Mark Edison and City Clerk Ricki Daniels.

Mayor Hatcher asked for a motion to dispense with the readings of the minutes from June. Peggy Druin made a motion to dispense with the minutes. Denver Matthews 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Peggy Druin made a motion to accept the minutes for June. Darlene Herps 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Peggy Druin made a motion to accept the financial report for June. Denver Matthews 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS

Fireworks: Councilwoman Peggy Druin stated she was still hearing fireworks weeks after July 4th. She asked if the officers could hand deliver a copy of the fireworks ordinance to violators. Chief Reynolds stated he would direct his officers to hand out copies of the ordinance to violators.

Door Bids: Mayor Hatcher provided the Council with a new bid from WillisKlein for replacing just the two doors in the assembly room at this time. The bid was for \$5,024.00 including installation. Gary Wilson made a motion to accept the bid from WillisKlein. Peggy Druin 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Nuisance Ordinance/Code Enforcement Board: Attorney Edison explained to have a code enforcement board we would have to have an inspector and a hearing board. They would be entitled to a salary, as well. He also stated that our nuisance ordinance could be stricter than the state statute. Currently we must give a 14 day notice to the homeowner. Beginning January 1, 2017, we will have to implement a new nuisance ordinance to adhere to the new statute. Attorney Edison will send letters to the 3 properties we have had the most complaints about.

Knox Regional Development Alliance: Darlene Herps made a motion to remove from the table the discussion on the Knox Regional Development Alliance. Denver Matthews 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried. Daniel Hall addressed the Council about the regional alliance that is proposed to assist in economic development to retain, attract and recruit new DoD missions. They are asking for a financial commitment of \$700 a year from the City of Pioneer Village for the next 5 years. Peggy Druin made a motion to table any decision until the entire Council was in attendance. Denver Matthews 2nd the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

1st Reading of Tax Ordinances 2016-06, 2016-07, and 2016-08: Mark Edison gave the 1st reading of tax ordinances 2016-06, 2016-07, and 2016-08.

COUNCIL BUSINESS

Councilwoman Druin asked the Mayor to look in to a drainage issue in the utility easement at 4714 Ridgeway Ct.

POLICE

Chief Reynolds introduced Nick Hibbs, who we have hired and will be going to the academy in November, 2016. He begins part-time on August 1, 2016 and full-time (ride-along) on September 17, 2016.

Chief Reynolds stated there had been thefts at Wee-Stor-It and Mini's U-Stuff-It recently. A suspect was arrested and is currently in jail. There was also a recent theft in Hebron Estates, of which they are looking at a suspect.


