

**City of Pioneer Village  
Regular City Council Meeting  
July 28, 2015**

Regular Meeting of the Pioneer Village City Council was held at City Hall Becknall Community Center, 4700 Summitt Drive, Louisville, KY 40229. Gary W. Hatcher called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Members present: Peggy Druin, Dorleen Garrett, Darlene Herps, Denver Matthews, Phillip Radford and Gary Wilson. Also in attendance were City Clerk Ricki Daniels and City Attorney Mark Edison.

Peggy Druin made a motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes for June. Darlene Herps 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried. Dorleen Garrett made a motion to accept the minutes for June. Peggy Druin 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of Ordinance #2015-04:** Attorney Edison gave the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Ordinance #2015-04, Annexation of Unincorporated Territory (Stone property). Peggy Druin made a motion to accept Ordinance #2015-04 as read. Dorleen Garrett 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of Ordinance #2015-05:** Attorney Edison gave the 2<sup>nd</sup> Reading of Ordinance #2015-05, Annexation of Unincorporated Territory (Robey property). Peggy Druin made a motion to accept Ordinance #2015-05 as read. Phillip Radford 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Ordinance #2015-06:** Attorney Edison gave the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Ordinance #2015-06, Levying Real Property Taxes.

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Ordinance #2015-07:** Attorney Edison gave the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Ordinance #2015-07, Levying Personal Property Taxes.

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Ordinance #2015-08:** Attorney Edison gave the 1<sup>st</sup> Reading of Ordinance #2015-08, Levying Public Service Taxes.

**Sign Ordinance:** Attorney Edison stated the US Supreme Court had announced a new standard of review of Sign Ordinances. He stated the City will have to look at its sign ordinances and likely make some changes.

**Delinquent Garbage Bill:** Attorney Edison stated there had been a judgment on a resident for a delinquent garbage bill. He stated he needed the Council to consider foreclosing on the property to collect the judgment. Dorleen Garrett made a motion to direct Attorney Edison to foreclose on the property to collect the judgment. Gary Wilson 2<sup>nd</sup> motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

**COUNCIL BUSINESS**

Councilwoman Peggy Druin stated the potholes on Spring Meadow Dr, have started to pop up again. Mayor Hatcher stated we would contact Walser.

Councilman Wilson asked if the Mayor could arrange to look at the drainage issue that Mr. Lee is concerned about. The Mayor said he had looked at the situation on several occasions over the past couple of months, during heavy rains, and he said the City would not be able to offer any assistance to correct their problem because there are no

easements between the homes. Mr. Lee asked if the drainage in the front of the homes could be altered to direct the water away from their homes. Mayor Hatcher stated it would be a very expensive solution, and he did not think he could justify the cost which would only affect a couple of homes.

**MAGISTRATE**

Magistrate Joe Laswell informed the Council after recently meeting with the State Road Department that the problem at Hebron Lane and Preston Hwy will be repaired in the coming months. He said the work would likely be contracted out. He also stated the final paving of the new section of Preston Highway would begin in about a week.

**POLICE REPORT**

Chief Reynolds reported that Officer Roederer had returned to work full-time.


