

**City of Pioneer Village  
Regular City Council Meeting  
September 27, 2016**

Regular Meeting of the Pioneer Village City Council was held at City Hall Becknall Community Center, 4700 Summitt Drive, Louisville, KY 40229. Gary W. Hatcher called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Members present: Peggy Druin, Dorleen Garrett, Darlene Herps, Denver Matthews, Phillip Radford and Gary Wilson. Others in attendance were City Clerk Ricki Daniels.

Mayor Hatcher asked for a motion to dispense with the readings of the minutes from August. Peggy Druin made a motion to dispense with the minutes. Darlene Herps 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Peggy Druin made a motion to accept the minutes for August. Dorleen Garrett 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Clean-up Day:** Mayor Hatcher reminded the Council of the clean-up day scheduled for Saturday, October 1, 2016 from 8-12. He asked for volunteers to help with the clean-up.

**New Doors:** Mayor Hatcher stated the new doors had been installed exiting the meeting room.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

**Mosquito Sprayer:** Mayor Hatcher stated he and Mayor Clark of Hebron Estates had discussed the possibility of purchasing a mosquito sprayer, and would share the cost of purchase and maintenance through an interlocal agreement. He provided the Council with information about the sprayer stating the cost for the sprayer would be \$5,340. It would need to be mounted on the back of a pickup. He stated we would attempt to purchase a pickup through the DMO Military Surplus, inexpensively. In addition, someone would have to be certified to use the equipment and sprayer. Mayor Hatcher stated he was only making the Council aware that he felt this may be something the City may consider as a joint effort with Hebron Estates to try to attack the problems with Zika, West Nile and other mosquitoes.

**Professional Office Solutions.** Mayor Hatcher stated the City would be losing a major contributor of occupational tax by the first of the year. Professional Office Solutions sold their business. The work will be outsourced to in-home medical decoders. The City will lose about \$10,000 a year. The owner of the building is hoping to rent the building out to another small call center, which would bring back some occupational revenue to the City.

### **COUNCIL BUSINESS**

Councilwoman Herps stated when Waste Management began picking up trash they avoided Lodie Lane until after rush hour, but now they are picking up during rush hour, making it difficult to get in and out of Lodie Lane. Clerk Daniels will contact Waste Management about the issue.

### **POLICE**

Chief Reynolds reported there had been a break in at the Mulch Company, but after an investigation they believe they know who committed the crime and would pursue the case.

**MAGISTRATE LASWELL** No report.




**ADJOURNMENT**
