

ORDINANCE RELATING TO PARKING AND THE ESTABLISHMENT
OF FIRE ACCESS ROADS.



Whereas a study of the traffic, parking and pedestrian usage in the City of Pioneer Village indicates a necessity for regulating parking on the streets in the City to promote the safety and well being of its residents;


Now therefore be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Kentucky, that:

1. There shall be no overnight parking on the streets in Pioneer Village.
2. Overnight parking as used herein shall mean from 8:00 P.M. until 6:00 A.M. the following day.
3. The streets of Summerset and Summitt are hereby designated as fire department access roads and no parking shall be permitted on the west side of Summitt from the city limits to the south property line of Maryville School nor shall parking be permitted on the north side of Summerset from its intersection with Summitt to 100 feet east therefrom.
4. Violation of paragraphs 1 or 3 hereof shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
5. All ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and should any court of competent jurisdiction declare any portion hereof void such decision shall not effect the remainder.

Passed at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Kentucky, on the 18 day of June, 1984. Votes for 4, Votes against 0, Abstentions .
