

ORDINANCE RELATING TO SPEED LIMITS
ON CITY STREETS

NO. 86- 2

WHEREAS: Upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, the speed permitted under Kentucky Revised Statutes 189.390, subsection 2, is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist on all streets within the city limits, except Preston Highway (Kentucky 61) and Hebron Lane (Kentucky 1526).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: No operator of a vehicle shall at any time drive at a speed in excess of twenty-five (25) miles per hour on any street within the city, except Preston Highway (Kentucky 61) and Hebron Lane (Kentucky 1526).

SECTION TWO: Appropriate signs and markings shall be erected and posted at the locations described in Section One hereof indicating the beginning and end of such twenty-five miles per hour speed zones as soon as practicable after the date of the adoption of this ordinance, and that twenty-five (25) miles per hour speed limit at such locations shall be effective from the time such warning signs and markings are erected and posted.

SECTION THREE: Any person who violates Section Two hereof shall be fined in accordance with those fines provided in KRS 189.394.

SECTION FOUR: Whereas, in order to protect the citizens of the City, it is necessary to declare an emergency and to waive second reading and to enact immediately to be effective immediately.

Passed at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Kentucky, on the 18th day of August, 1986, an emergency having been declared by a vote of two-thirds of the Council.
