

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, KENTUCKY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 1985 to JUNE 30, 1986

ORDINANCE NO. ~~87~~-1

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Kentucky, that the budget ordinance for the fiscal year July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1986, is amended as follows:

SECTION I. The general fund accounts are amended as follows:

- A. General property tax revenues are amended from \$38,000.00 to \$15,320.
- B. Licenses are amended from \$0.00 to \$150.00.
- C. Intergovernmental revenues are amended from \$9,500.00 to \$7,321.00.
- D. Interest revenues are amended from \$0.00 to \$18.00.
- E. Other revenues are amended from \$0.00 to \$169.00.
- F. Total revenues are amended from \$47,500.00 to \$22,978.00.
- G. General government expenditures are amended from \$15,858.00 to \$12,083.00.
- H. Police expenditures are amended from \$9,400.00 to \$5,899.00.
- I. Streets expenditures are amended from \$10,500.00 to \$4,350.00.
- J. Public safety expenditures are amended from \$2,900.00 to \$4,163.00.
- K. Debt service expenditures are amended from \$5,000.00 to \$10,549.00.
- L. Emergency discretionary expenditures are amended from \$3,500.00 to \$0.00.
- M. Total expenditures are amended from \$47,158.00 to \$37,044.00.

SECTION II. The special revenue accounts are amended as follows:

- A. Intergovernmental revenues are amended from \$800.00 to \$2,653.00.
- B. Interest revenues are amended from \$0.00 to \$44.00.
- C. Total revenues are amended from \$800.00 to \$2,697.00.

D. Public safety expenditures are amended from \$1,900.00 to \$0.00.

E. Total expenditures are amended from \$1,900.00 to \$0.00.

SECTION III. The capital projects accounts are amended as follows:

A. General government expenditures are amended from \$ .00 to \$36.00.

B. Total expenditures are amended from \$ .00 to \$36.00.

SECTION IV. This ordinance shall be published according to law and shall become effective upon publication.


