

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 85-1 TO
CORRECT DEFECTS IN SECTION 5; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

ORDINANCE NO. 90-2

RECITALS

Ordinance No. 85-1 was passed by the City Council of Pioneer Village on March 18, 1985, and in said Ordinance there was a failure to make provisions for businesses not specifically enumerated and set out therein, and it was the intention of the City Council to include all businesses as being required to obtain a license, and

Now, therefore, the City Council of Pioneer Village ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Ordinance No. 85-1 is hereby amended to state the true intention of the City Council by adding as Sentence 25 to Group H the following: (Any businesses, occupations, trades, and/or professions carried on or conducted with the City of Pioneer Village and not specifically enumerated within this Ordinance shall pay \$25.00.)

SECTION II. Effective date since immediate operation of the provisions of this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety, and emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon publication.
