

Swimming Pool

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ENCLOSURE OF ANY SWIMMING POOL
WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 90-3

That whereas it is a matter of public welfare and public concern as to the safety of all residents of the City of Pioneer Village, and the City Council finding that to protect the safety and well being of all citizens of the city from the hazards presented by private swimming pools, the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I. That all swimming pools within the corporate boundaries of the City of Pioneer Village and having a depth of 3 or more feet shall be totally enclosed by a fence of not less than 6 feet in height. Any gate installed shall further have provisions for and shall contain a latch or lock to secure said gate to prevent the general public from gaining entry to the pool when it is unattended.

SECTION II. Any person violating this ordinance shall be fined the sum of \$10.00 per day for each offense. Each day during which a violation occurs or exists constituting a separate offense for which an additional fine of \$10.00 may be assessed.

SECTION III. This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication.

SECTION IV. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed.

SECTION V. Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same ~~not~~ may not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
