

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS
WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, KENTUCKY

ORDINANCE NO. 90-5

That whereas it is a matter of public welfare and public concern as to the safety of all residents of the City of Pioneer Village, and the City Council finding that to protect the safety and well being of all citizens of the city from the hazards presented by vehicles parking and or blocking city streets, the city council of the City of Pioneer Village does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I. That it shall be unlawful to park on or block any portion of any city street within the corporate limits of the City of Pioneer Village from ~~_____ p.m. to _____ a.m.~~ *At Any Time*

SECTION II. Any person violating this ordinance shall be fined the sum of 10.00 for each offense. Said fine may be enforced administratively or under the criminal sanctions of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

SECTION III. Any person or entity who has been cited for violation of this ordinance and has failed to satisfy the penalty as set out herein may on a subsequent offense be subject to having the vehicle towed at the owners expense.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall become effective upon publication.

SECTION V. All Ordinances or parts of any Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed.

SECTION VI. Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
