

An Order of the City Council of Pioneer Village
Relating to the Employment of a Building Inspector for the City
of Pioneer Village.

Whereas, the City of Pioneer Village, Kentucky, is required
pursuant to K.R.S. 198B.060 to employ a Building Inspector for
the enforcement of the Uniform State Building Code;

Therefore, be it ordained by the city council of Pioneer
Village, Kentucky

Section One: The City of Pioneer Village shall retain the
service of a Building Inspector, to provide all building
inspections pursuant to K.R.S. 198B.060, within the municipal
boundaries of Pioneer Village.

Section Two: All inspection fees shall be collected by
the City Clerk/Treasurer or a designated agent of that office
upon the issuance of a City Building Permit and shall be paid to
the inspector upon completion of inspection services for that
building.

Section Three: The Building Inspector retained pursuant to
this ordinance shall act as an independent contractor and not as
an employee of the City of Pioneer Village.

Section Four: All fees charged by the Building Inspector
shall be in accordance with K.R.S. 198B.060 and must be approved
by the City Council

Section Five: The Clerk is directed to advertise the above
as provided by law.

Section Six: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not effect the remainder of this Ordinance.

Given first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 18th day of March, 1991. Given second reading, voted upon and passed at a regular meeting of the City Council of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 15th day of April, 1991.
