

ORDINANCE NO. 92-4

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING TO RESCIND ORDINANCE NO. 91-02 ANNEXING PROPERTY SOUTH AND WEST OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, as follows:


SECTION I: The City Council of the City of Pioneer Village has enacted an ordinance proposing annexation of property south and west of Pioneer Village as enacted by Ordinance No. 91-02. The City Council has heard objections from residents in this area, and no longer desires to annex those individuals who have opposition to the annexation.

SECTION II: The City Council of the City of Pioneer Village does hereby ordain that Ordinance No. 91-02 be rescinded, held for naught and have no effect.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall be published according to law.


