

ORDINANCE NO. 92- 10

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky.

The City Council finding for the betterment, peace, dignity and gratitude of the community, and to promote public safety, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful to park a motor vehicle on right of ways within the corporate boundaries of the city limits of Pioneer Village for a period of more than 8 hours continuously at any time.

SECTION II: Definition.

Truck: A truck with a load capacity of over 1000 pounds.

Boat: A rowboat, motor boat, or houseboat.

Van or recreation vehicle: That device utilized for lodging on a temporary basis that is mobile.

SECTION III: It shall be unlawful to park a truck, trailer, camper, bus or boat, except for immediate loading or unloading, on any thoroughfare or right of way within the corporate boundaries of the City of Pioneer Village. It shall be unlawful to park a truck, boat, RV vehicle, camper or bus, in the front yard or on a private driveway of a residential lot between a line along the front of an existing building on the lot and the paved portion of the public street; and further on any street within an area zoned as residential.

SECTION IV: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance for which a penalty is not otherwise provided shall be fined not less than \$5 and not more than \$25 for each offense.

SECTION V: Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause or section or part of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any particular case is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect or repeal any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, or section or parts of this Ordinance, it being the legislative intent of the city council to ordain and enact each provision, section, paragraph, sentence and part hereof separately and independently of each other.

SECTION VI: Other Ordinances Not Repealed. Nothing contained herein shall be deemed to repeal or modify any other ordinance heretofore enacted and in force in the City of Pioneer Village, unless specifically repealed by separate ordinance.
