

ORDINANCE NO. 93- 12

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, in order to promote the health and safety of its citizens, to promote the general welfare and to establish a peaceful and tranquil community that is healthy, hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I: It shall be unlawful for any person within the city to make, continue, or cause to be made or continued any loud, unnecessary, or unusual noise which either annoys, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety of others; unless the making and continuing of the noise is necessary for the protection or preservation of the property, health, safety, life or limb of the person.

SECTION II: It shall be unlawful to:

(a) Sound any horn or signal device on any vehicle not in motion, except as a danger warning if another vehicle is approaching apparently out of control;

(b) Sound any horn or signal device on any vehicle in motion except as a danger warning after or as an attempt is made to decelerate the vehicle by the application of brakes;

(c) Sound any horn or signal device on any vehicle for an unnecessary and unreasonable period of time or in such manner as to create an unreasonably loud or harsh sound;

(d) Use or operate any vehicle which produces, or use or operate any vehicle so out of repair or so loaded with any material as to cause any loud and unnecessary grating, grinding, rattling, or other loud and excessive noise;

(e) Discharge into the open air the exhaust of any vehicle except through a muffler or other device which will effectively prevent loud or explosive noises therefrom;

(f) Create any loud and excessive noises in connection with loading or unloading any vehicle;

(g) Use any mechanical loudspeaker or amplifiers on any moving or standing vehicle for advertising or other purposes.

SECTION III: Unsupervised Use of Burglar Alarms Prohibited

(a) It shall be unlawful for any owner of a burglar alarm to allow it to emit a noise level that effects a nuisance to the surrounding areas for a period in excess of one hour.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any owner of a burglar alarm to allow it to continuously set off false alarms during any 24-hour period. "Continuously" shall be defined in its normal course of usage and shall include not in a frequency of more than three times per day.

SECTION IV: Whoever violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$25.00 for each offense.


SECTION V: Any portion or provision of this Ordinance which would be rendered ineffective or void for any reason shall not effect the remainder of same.
