


**SUMMARY OF
ORDINANCE NO. 000-01**

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING REGULATIONS OF BULLITT COUNTY AND ALL CITIES WITHIN ITS BOUNDARIES RELATING TO EARTH PRODUCTS AND THE EXTRACTION FROM ABOVE AND BELOW GROUND AND REHABILITATION OF ABOVE GROUND SITES AS IT APPLIES TO PROPERTY LYING WITHIN THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

Ordinance No. 000-01 relates to the amendment of the Official Zoning Regulations of Bullitt County and all cities within its boundaries relating to Earth Products and the Extraction from above and below ground and rehabilitation of above ground sites as it applies to property lying within the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky. The full terms, deletions, additions and conditions are set forth in full in the Ordinance and may be viewed at the City Clerk's Office.

ORDINANCE NO. 000-01

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AMENDMENT OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING REGULATIONS OF BULLITT COUNTY AND ALL CITIES WITHIN ITS BOUNDARIES RELATING TO EARTH PRODUCTS AND THE EXTRACTION FROM ABOVE AND BELOW GROUND AND REHABILITATION OF ABOVE GROUND SITES AS IT APPLIES TO PROPERTY LYING WITHIN THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

Whereas, some legislative bodies were precluded by a prior action of taking action upon Zoning Text Amendment 95T-01, and,

Whereas, in order to avoid confusion or dispute concerning said Text Amendment the City of Shepherdsville submitted a Text Amendment 2000T-01 to the Planning Commission in accord with Kentucky Revised Statute 100.211 as a complete proposed text amendment and being described as Bullitt County Planning and Zoning Commission Text Amendment 2000T-01, and,

Whereas, the Planning Commission held a public hearing following due notice at which time it rejected the proposed amendment, and,

Whereas, the City of Pioneer Village finds the need and necessity for the provisions relating to Earth Products extraction in general and underground mining in particular and feeling the need that minimal reclamation provisions should apply with respect to the open pit method of mining,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PIONEER VILLAGE, BULLITT COUNTY, KENTUCKY THAT:

SECTION ONE: The Planning and Zoning Text Amendment 2000T-01 is hereby adopted to the Official Zoning Regulations of Bullitt County and all cities within its boundaries as it applies to property lying within the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky. A complete copy thereof is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though set forth in full as Exhibit A.

SECTION TWO: This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

SECTION THREE: Should any section, clause, line, paragraph or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not effect the remainder of this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance are hereby repealed

Given first reading at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky, on the 2nd day of May, 2000. Given second reading at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Pioneer Village, Bullitt County, Kentucky on the 6 day of June, 2000.
