Minutes: Motion to approve March 4, 2008 minutes with one correction, remove "square foot". Motion was made to approve the minutes with one correction by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Passed 3/0.

Budget: A copy of the Monthly Statement was handed out and reviewed. Motion to accept monthly statement was made by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Tucker; Motion Passed 3/0.

Mayor Clark announced a special budget meeting set for April 15th at 6:00pm at the Community Center.


Mayor Clark also reminded everyone that the office summer hours from 5:30pm to 7:00 pm would be in effect beginning on May 1st.
