

**City of Hebron Estates Minutes**  
**City Community Center**  
**August 6, 2013**  
**7:00 p.m.**

**Present:** Mayor Clark, Commissioners Denner, Forshee, Tucker, Merrifield, Clerk Picheo, Atty. Edison, Mayor Hatcher, Magistrate Laswell, Chief Reynolds, Pioneer News Representative and 2 guests.

**Minutes:** Motion to approve June 4, 2013 minutes was made by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Passed 4/0.

**Budget:** A copy of the monthly budget statement was handed out. Motion was made to pay August and September budgeted bills by Comm. Denner and seconded by Comm. Tucker; Passed 4/0.

**Chief Reynolds:** Provided an update to the council regarding officers had returned to provide additional nightshift coverage. He also reminded the council that they will be on patrol more with school starting.

**Old Business:** Mayor Clark led a discussion on getting the community center painted. He and the council reviewed the bids. A motion was made by Comm. Merrifield to accept the bid from Larry Mikesell to paint the community center (including walls, trim and ceilings) and was seconded by Comm. Tucker; Passed 4/0.

Mayor Clark and Atty. Edison gave an update regarding the Chambers suit. The Mayor explained that it was apparently lost in bankruptcy court and a warning order had been issued giving the attorney's 50 days to file a report.

Mayor Clark told the council that the Allstate property had been mowed and lien had been placed.

The mayor also gave an update on property at 3808 Scenic Trail. A letter was sent if it is not cut the city will have it cut and place a lien.

The Mayor also provided an update to the research regarding the Robbard's property behind North Bullitt. The city cannot annex because it is annexed under the city of Hillview.

**New Business:**

Mayor Clark led a discussion on getting cracks fill and sealed with the city's parking lot. Motion was made to have Reid Brothers fill cracks and reseal parking lot for \$2659.00 by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Denner ; Passed 4/0.

Mayor Clark led a discussion on road repairs for Waterfall, Cabin Court, and Creekview. Motion was made to repave these streets in the amount of \$34,375.00 by Comm. Tucker, and seconded by Comm. Forshee; Passed 4/0.

Atty. Edison gave a first reading on Ordinance 2013-02 Real Property Ad Valorem (2013 Tax rate on property). Atty. Edison gave a first reading on Ordinance 2013-03 Tax Rate for Utilities companies.

Mayor Clark also advise the council that the city was going through the process of the annual audit.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 pm was made by Comm. Tucker and seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 4/0.
