Present: Mayor Clark, Commissioners Denner, Forshee, Clerk Picheo, Atty. Edison, Mayor Hatcher, Chief Reynolds, Pioneer News Representative and 3 guests.

Minutes: Motion to approve Sept 3, 2013 minutes was made by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 2/0.

Budget: A copy of the monthly budget statement was handed out. Motion was made to pay October budgeted bills by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 2/0.

Chief Reynolds: Provided an update regarding the new traffic pattern. Residents were happy about the change and have communicated that to him and the students do not seem to mind either.

Old Business: Mayor Clark along with Atty. Edison gave an update on the Federal Government guidelines regarding street signs. According to the information received it appears that the city will be able to keep the posts for the street signs but will need to be moved back. Mayor Clark explained that the signs will all have to be reflective and the city has started replacing signs with reflective letterings.

Mayor Clark explained to the council that we may not receive our HB413 monies from the state. The city has tried numerous times to get the funds but has been unsuccessful even with the attempt of Atty. Edison.


Mayor Clark gave an update on the stream walk. He explained that he received reports that it went well and that 32 people showed up.
