

**City of Hebron Estates Minutes
City Community Center
November 5, 2013
7:00 p.m.**

Present: Mayor Clark, Commissioners Denner, Forshee, Clerk Picheo, Atty. Edison, Chief Reynolds, Pioneer News Representative and 3 guests.

Minutes: Motion to approve October 1, 2013 minutes with two corrections (add ditch line for description of Nalley's property and 4th quarter for 2011 HB 413) was made by Comm. Merrifield and seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 4/0.

Budget: A copy of the monthly budget statement was handed out. Motion was made to pay November budgeted bills by Comm. Forshee and seconded by Comm. Denner; Passed 4/0.

Chief Reynolds: Provided an update regarding the new traffic pattern still going good. Residents were happy about the change and have communicated that to him and the students do not seem to mind either. Chief also told the council that they had stopped a speeder on Burkland.

Old Business: Mayor Clark along with Atty. Edison gave an update on the Federal Government guidelines regarding street signs. According to the information received it appears that the city will be able to keep the posts for the street signs but will need to be moved back. Mayor Clark explained that the signs will all have to be reflective and the city has started replacing signs with reflective letterings. Mayor Clark also explained that he along with some of the other city mayors were going meet to discuss the changes, to ensure everyone understands what is going on.

Mayor Clark explained to the council that the city did receive money for the Chambers liens.

New Business: A discussion was led on the stumps located on East Hebron Lane. Mayor Clark led a discussion on pine trees that had been cut down by the property owner to help with visibility on the street and to help prevent trees from damaging the power lines. Council discussed concerns with the stumps near roadway. Motion was made to remove the stumps on easement by Comm. Denner and seconded by Comm. Tucker; passed 4/0.

Clerk Picheo explained that all the tax bills had been sent out.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 pm was made by Comm. Denner and seconded by Comm. Merrifield; Passed 4/0.
