## NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Hatcher explained specifics of Resolution NO. 20-03 A Resolution Supporting Addressing the Modernization of Kentucky's Transportation Funding Mechanisms to Address Transportation Funding Needed Throughout the Commonwealth: Mayor Hatcher states this resolution directly effects the Municipal Road Aid Fund for the City. Over the past ten years we have lost approximately \$14,000 dollars per year totaling \$140,000 in losses. Attorney Edison said most Cities cannot raise taxes to pay for road repair and have lost over 47 million dollars of road funds. Also, this Resolution is asking the legislature to investigate into ways to fund the roads. Peggy Druin stated the gas tax would be the fairest way to pay for roads. Attorney Edison read Resolution 20-03. Peggy Druin made a motion to adopt Resolution No. 20-03 A Resolution Supporting Addressing the Modernization of Kentucky's Transportation Funding Mechanisms to Address Transportation Funding Needed Throughout the Commonwealth. 


